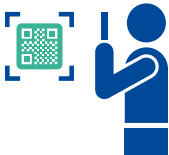

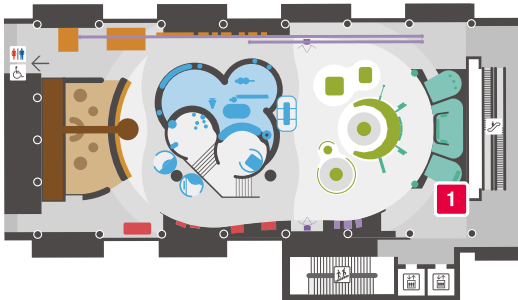

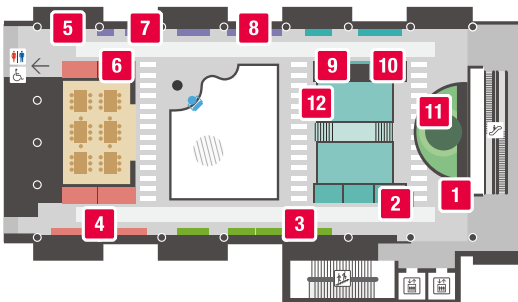
Floor map where audio guide is available

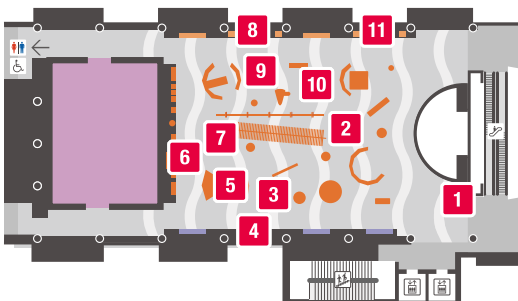
